In ***Hosea 14:2*** their prayer was simple.

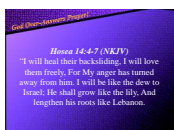
Israel asked "Lord, have mercy. Cleanse us - receive us back into Your grace."

Listen to what the Lord said he would do:

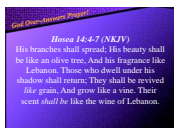
***Hosea 14:4-7 (NKJV)*** "I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely, For My anger has turned away from him. I will be like the dew to Israel; He shall grow like the lily, And lengthen his roots like Lebanon.

His branches shall spread; His beauty shall be like an olive tree, And his fragrance like Lebanon. Those who dwell under his shadow shall return; They shall be revived *like* grain, And grow like a vine. Their scent *shall be* like the wine of Lebanon.

***There had been a severe drought.***

Everything was dying because God's favor had been taken away.

***You asked only to be saved and cleansed.***

God has poured out blessing upon blessing to you!

***God Over-Answered Solomon's prayer!***

***In 1 Kings 3:9 Solomon prayed "Lord all I want is wisdom to know how to handle Your people. I only want to be a just king."***

***It was a simple request.***

***God answered Solomon's prayer in an incredible way:***

***1 Kings 3:11-12 (NKJV) Then God said to him:***

***"Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked long life for yourself, nor have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies, but have asked for yourself understanding to discern justice,***

***behold, I have done according to your words; see, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you.***

***God is anxious is to Over Answer unselfish prayers!***

Solomon asked for an understanding heart of discernment.

God not only gave him a wise heart

God promised to make him wiser than anyone else...

Yet, God didn't stop there.

<p>#9</p> 	<p><b>1 Kings 3:13-14 (NKJV)</b> I have also given you what you have not asked: both riches and honor, so that there shall not be anyone like you among the kings all your days.</p>
<p>#10</p> 	<p>So if you walk in My ways, to keep My statutes and My commandments, as your father David walked, then I will lengthen your days.”</p>
	<p>What an incredible response!          God added to Solomon's wisdom -blessings, honor, and riches above all other men.          On top of that, He gave him a prolonged life: "I will lengthen thy days."</p>
<p>#11</p> 	<p><b><i>God Over Answered Israel regarding the Ammonites!</i></b>  <b>Judges 10:9</b> "Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight... so that Israel was sore distressed".</p>
	<p><b><i>Ammon's army was marching toward Israel!</i></b>          God's people were perplexed and downcast</p>
<p>#12</p> 	<p><b><i>Because of their troubles they began to confess their sins:</i></b>  <b>Judges 10:15</b> “We have sinned! Do to us whatever seems best to You; only deliver us this day, we pray.”          They were haunted by their sin.          They only asked God to spare them.          Their prayer was simple: "<b><i>Lord, deliver us just this one time! Don't let us be defeated or overrun by our</i></b></p>

**enemy!"**

***They prayed for a single victory.***

But, God had something more in mind.

God Over Answered their prayer mightily!

God gave protection

They totally subdued the Ammonites!

They had total victory.

***That is just how God wants to Over Answer His people today!***

Most Christians pray, "Lord, I need victory today."

God says, "I'll give you that - but I have much more in store for you!

God wants to subdue your enemy.

**Our Father loves to give to us!**

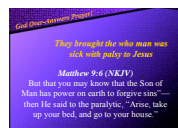
He loves to Over Answer our cry!

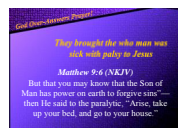
**Matthew 7:11 (NKJV)** If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, **how much more will your Father** who is in heaven give good
