There is a burden of sin.***

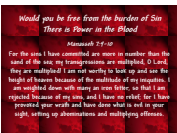
Psalm 38:4 For my iniquities have gone over my head; Like a heavy burden they are too heavy for me.

- Romans 6:23 the wages of sin [is] death..

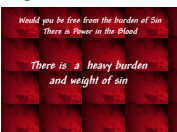

They feel there is nothing they can do.

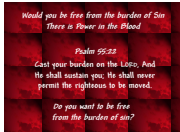
It is too late now.

Saul of Tarsus had much to regret.

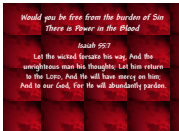
The weight of his sins was heavy on him.

The blood Jesus shed on the cross still has power today and is the key to every victory in your life.

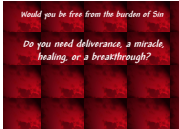
It's encouraging knowing that your situation is only temporary... the power of the blood has you covered and will guide you through your storms.

The enemy is still out to steal, kill and destroy you, your children, your dreams and your destiny.

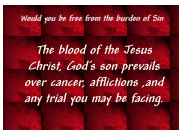
But, never forget the battle is the Lord's.
