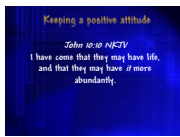

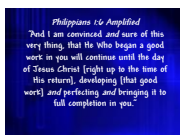
Our salvation deals with the here and the now and it also covers eternity.

He believed that he was going to succeed in what he was doing.

He did not start building that thing with the notion it would not float.

Daniel had an attitude -

He was not going to bend or bow.

He faced the lions with an attitude.

Keep looking at those heroes.

They kept a positive attitude of faith and trust in God.

They kept a positive attitude of expectation from God.

What is the definition of faith, expectation, and attitude?
Faith - the absolute certainty in the trustworthiness of another
Expectation - the confident anticipation that an event will happen
Attitude - a manner of being, feeling or thinking that shows one's disposition or opinion

What is the definition of faith, expectation, and attitude?

Faith - the absolute certainty in the trustworthiness of another, specifically here trust in God.

Expectation - the confident anticipation that an event will happen, God said it would and it will.

Attitude - a manner of acting, feeling or thinking that shows one's disposition or opinion

Developing and keeping a positive attitude of expectation is a progressive process.

It is developed by hearing, reading, mediating, and speaking the Word of God.

God was behind the positive faith of the heroes of faith in Hebrews 11.

They all heard a Word from God.

They believed that God was faithful to what He said.

They held on to that Word.

They refused to give up on what God said.

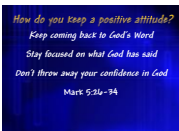
They based their life and their future on His Word.

You have to stay focused on what God has said.

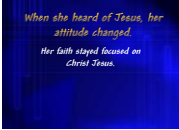
Don't throw away your confidence in God.

Her faith stayed focused on Christ Jesus.

You need to understand what this woman did.

No one promised her that if she would do this she would be healed.

She simply heard of Jesus and what He had done.

She took positive action against the odds.

She had nothing to look forward to in this life.

She was financially hopeless.

She was medically hopeless.

She was a social outcast, because of her situation.

She was spiritually unclean.

She got an attitude.

When you get an attitude and decide to do something with it, you become a participator of God's provision.

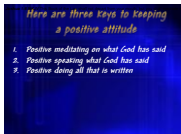

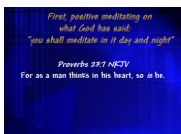

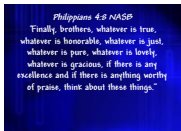
*First, positive meditating on what God has said:

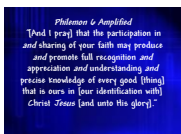
