John 8:36 Amplified So if the Son liberates you [makes you free men], then you are really *and* unquestionably free.

The life of the overcomer is absolutely foreign to most of us.

We have all known and lived with the power of sin.

We have known the weakness of the flesh.

We have made excuses for our frailty, faults, and failures.

We have grown up with our old nature and characteristics.

We have accepted the chains of enslavement to old ideals, and lifestyle patterns.

The reason the life of faith is hard is that the natural man has trouble accepting the liberating victory that Christ Jesus has achieved for us.

Faith in Jesus Christ cannot be built on abstract reasoning.

It is only built by accepting God's Word, acting on it, and letting His Word live in us.

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Romans 8:31-33 Amplified What then shall we say to [all] this? If God is for us, who [can be] against us? [Who can be our foe, if God is on our side?] He who did not withhold *or* spare [even] His own Son but gave Him up for us all, will He not also with Him freely *and* graciously give us all [other] things?

Who shall bring any charge against God's elect [when it is] God Who justifies [that is, Who puts us in right relation to Himself? Who shall come forward and accuse or impeach those whom God has chosen? Will God, Who acquits us?]

If God is for us, who can be against us?

We should be established, securely settled, unconditionally grounded, in that.

By this time you should know that God is for you.

He is your Father.

He gave up His Son to die for you.

He has appropriated and provided His life for you.

He has chosen and adopted you.

He has imparted and implanted His own nature in you.

Do you have that deep settled calm assurance that you have Jesus Christ living in your life?

No one can touch the branch of the vine without hurting the vine.

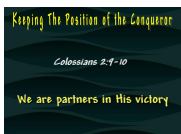
The vine and the branch have been vitally connected.

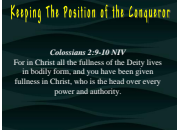


***We are partners in His victory.

You are His beloved.

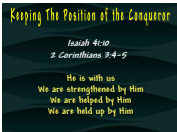
Your Father in heaven is looking over toward His right hand where His Son, Jesus Christ, is seated.

We are helped by Him.

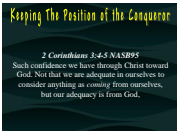
