The grace of God has brought us into a New Position
Titus 3:7 NIV “so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.”
Colossians 2:8 NIV “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God”

***The grace of God has brought us into a New Position
 By His grace He has redeemed us from our sins.***

Titus 3:7 NIV “so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.”

Ephesians 2:8 NIV “For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God”

***Titus investigates what God’s grace has done for us.
 He tells us that Grace has justified us so that we might become heirs of the hope of eternal life.***

Hebrews 2:14-15 NIV
 Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

This is the initiation of the New Position that grace brings us into.

It is by grace you have been saved.

The gift of grace is eternal life.

This is a radically New Position for us.

Ever since sin was introduced, man has lived in a position of death and the fear of death.

Most of us know that position very well.

This is why Jesus Christ came into this world.

Hebrews 2:14-15 NIV Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil—and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

We are now in a Position of Life!!

2 Timothy 1:9-10 NIV
 This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

What does it mean to be in a position of life?

Everything that proceeds from the Grace of God and the work of Jesus Christ testifies of life.

2 Timothy 1:9-10 NIV This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

The Gospel is all about bringing us out of darkness and death into life and light.

When Jesus Christ conquered death and the grave He defeated Satan as our Substitute.

Satan's defeat is an eternal reality.

By defeating Satan, Jesus made it possible for us to attain a new position.
We are now more than conquerors through Christ.
When Jesus Christ ascended into Heaven, all of Satan's power and ability was destroyed.
The Position of the Church is the position of the redeemed.
The Church does not stand in a different position from its Lord.
The redeemed of the Lord have been brought into the victory of Jesus Christ.
Grace has brought us into this new position.

2 Corinthians 6:1-2 NIV As God's fellow workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.

Not everyone who has received grace is walking in the victory of Jesus Christ.

It is possible to receive God's grace and favor, and not stand in the position of the redeemed.

Through Christ Jesus our Lord, God has placed us in a position of success.

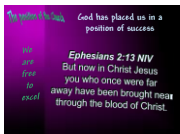
In this New Position, we are free to excel.

Exhortation Everyone who has been redeemed is not living in a position of success
Many Christians are not living in excellence

Everyone who has been redeemed is not living in a position of success

Many are walking defeated.

Many Christians are not living in excellence.

Many are falling below the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ.

You may be redeemed by the blood of Christ and live like you are still under the curse.

You may be an heir of the riches of heaven and fail to live in the grace and favor of God.

It is a matter of choice and knowledge.

Many people don't know that they can live any differently.

They may be free but they don't know they are free.

They are not aware that Christ has given them the ability to live above the things that are not like Christ.

What does that really mean?

You need to see that the death of the Lord Jesus Christ has dealt with the old nature, attitudes, and activities.

It is not enough to talk about newness of life.

We must live in the excellence of it.

We must come into the position of a Son of God.

We must arise from where we have been into new life in Christ.

Jonathan Edwards: "One that stands or walks in slippery places is always exposed to fall."

What should be under our feet is controlling many of us.

We should be a testimony of the excellence of Christ Jesus' victory.

Our lives should be marked with excellence of thought.

We must take responsibility for our thought life.

The only way we can truly be successful in this is by developing the mind of Christ.

It is impossible for us to control all of our thoughts.

There are too many random thoughts that fly through the brain.

However, we can control thought processes in such a way that evil thoughts are instantly rejected.

Jonathan Edwards said: "One that stands or walks in slippery places is always exposed to fall."

This is very true about our thought life.

Irresponsible thinking has consequences.

"Slippery places" are not just a danger to others.
