Sometimes we lose consciousness of what that means.

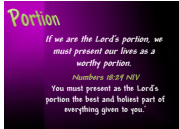
We are in God's hands, as a treasure.

This position is a relationship.

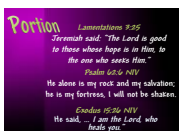
I belong to Jesus.

He is our deliverer.

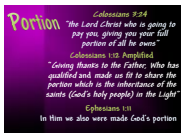
He is our hope.
