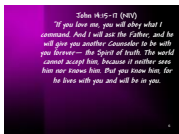

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 (NIV)
For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds, to demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ.

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We are not of the world and we are not like the world.

Ephesians says we have been seated with Christ. Our hearts have been captivated by Christ.

We have been given supernatural power to demolish strongholds, arguments, and every pretension that sets up against the knowledge of God.

2 Corinthians 10:3-5 Amplified
For though we walk (live) in the flesh, we are not carrying on our warfare according to the flesh and using mere human weapons. For the weapons of our warfare are not physical weapons of flesh and blood, but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds, [inasmuch as we] refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God, and we lead every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One).

We must certify our relationship with Christ.

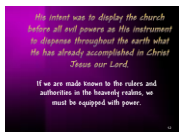
We must be covered with His righteousness.
