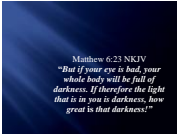

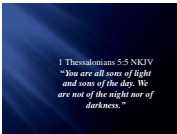

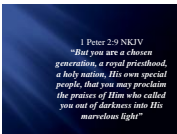
Ephesians 5:8 NKJV "For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light"

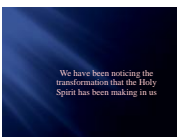

A church without spot or wrinkle.

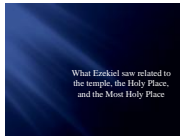
He is constantly moving us toward that perfection.

When God came down, that radiant glory of divine light illuminated the whole house.

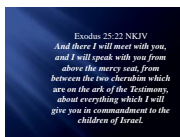
From a place within, God would commune with them.

Propitiation ἱλαστήριον
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 expiatory (place or thing), that is an
 atoning victim, or (specifically) the
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 mercy seat propitiation.

The word *propitiation* is ἱλαστήριον **hilastēriōn**, *hil-as-tay'-ree-on*; an *expiatory* (place or thing), such as an *atoning victim*, or (specifically) the *lid* of the Ark (in the Temple):— the mercy seat, propitiation.

The Redemption that is in Christ Jesus has brought us into a place where we may commune with God.

Jesus Christ is our meeting place.

He is a place where God in mercy meets with us.

There is no place for the natural man to meet with God outside of Jesus Christ.

Saul of Tarsus was on the Damascus road when he had an encounter with the glory of God.

He was looking up into the face of Jesus Christ.

He said there was a light from heaven that was brighter than the sun.

He was blinded by the brilliance and radiant glory of that light.

There is no place for the natural man in the presence of that light.

The glory of God in the face of Jesus has a dramatic impact on us.
