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Evidence of the Anointing in Your Life

John 1:14 NIV The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

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Jesus, the Christ, is the One who is anointed above all others.

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He came into this world, as man, demonstrating the glory of God.

As Jesus was baptized by John, the Holy Spirit descended on Him in bodily form like a dove. (Mark 1:10)

Luke 4:1 NIV "Jesus, full of the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit in the desert"

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Luke 4:14 NIV

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Being sent by the Father, the power of the Spirit was the animating force in Jesus Christ.

Luke 4:18 NIV

"The Spirit of the Lord is on me, because He has anointed Me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners and recovery of sight for the blind, to release the oppressed."

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This demonstration of the glory and power of God is something that interests each of us.

Jesus Christ is God's Anointed One.

John 1:51 NIV

He then added, "I tell you the truth, you shall see heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

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The fulfillment of this is seen in the transfiguration of Christ in Luke 9.

Luke 9:32 NIV

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(Moses and Elijah)

There was something glorious about Jesus Christ.

We noticed the transfer of God's radiant Glory and Anointing in the Old and New Testaments.

Moses' face became radiant with the glory of God.

Peter and John saw the Glory of God change the entire appearance of Jesus Christ.

From His head to His toes the glory of God radiated. Even His clothing radiated with the glory of God.

What did Jesus do with that glory and that anointing?

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He came down from the mount and healed a boy with a demon, who had seizures and was suffering greatly. (Matthew 17:1-16)

By that glory and anointing Jesus ministered in power and in perfect harmony with God's intent and purpose.

Jesus lived and ministered within that glory and anointing.

That glory and anointing remained upon Him.

When the Disciples could not discern or perceive the glory and anointing, it was within and upon Jesus Christ.

From that anointing Jesus ministered to the world.
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Everything that Jesus Christ was observed to be, doing, and give was from the dynamic of the anointing that was upon Him.

He worked, ministered, and lived in the Anointing of the Holy Spirit.

His Disciples said, "We have seen His glory."

 "From the fullness of His grace we have all received one blessing after another."
 That quickening is the life giving force of the Holy Spirit's anointing on us and within us.

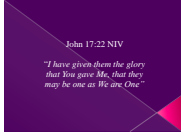
John 1:16 NIV "From the fullness of His grace we have all received one blessing after another."

We have already studied the fact that He has quickened us together with Christ.

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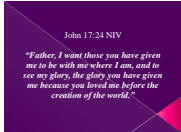
Now listen to what the Lord Jesus Christ says about the glory that He possessed.

John 17:24 NIV “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.”

What is the Lord saying to us about this?

What is the meaning and reality of the anointing of the Holy Spirit?

These verses depict a revelation of the glory of God on Jesus Christ, the Son.

They tell us that the Son is giving us of His glory and anointing.

Jesus said He wants us to receive the glory that He was given by the Father.

What impact does the anointing and glory that was committed to Jesus Christ, have on us?

What impact did it have on Jesus?

What impact will it have on our lives?

Look at this verse again:

John 1:16 NIV “From the fullness of His grace we have all received one blessing after another.”

His grace has not only saved us, it has transformed our lives.

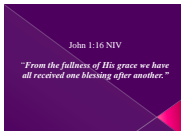
We have been changed.

Galatians 5:16-21 NIV
So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want.

The impact of this is dramatic.

If you have received Christ, this will dramatically change your life.

The Life of the Spirit changes our nature.

Galatians 5:16-21 NIV
But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under law. The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft;

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Galatians 5:16-21 NIV
hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

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If we have received the same Spirit that anointed, empowered, and equipped the ministry of Jesus Christ, we must demonstrate the same fruit of that ministry.

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The old weak carnal nature must be overwhelmed in victory and power.

As long as we are controlled by our old carnal and fleshly nature we will live in defeat and below the level of effectiveness that God wants.

Why do we want the anointing of the Holy Spirit?

Do you want to do great and powerful things?

Do you want to have influence to change circumstances and situations?

The first and pre-eminent thing the anointing and glory of God does is take everything out of our hands.

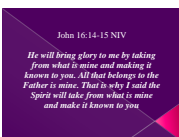
The anointing takes charge of reputation.

The anointing takes charge of our lives.

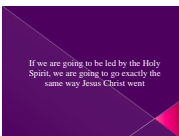
When everything is in the control of the Holy Spirit, He has freedom to work from Heaven's directives.

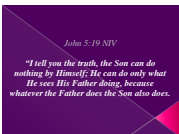

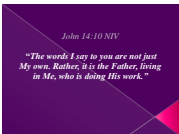
If we are going to be led by the Holy Spirit, we are going to go exactly the same way Jesus Christ went.

 When the Holy Spirit comes He will take what belongs to Jesus Christ and make it known to you. (John 16:14-15)

What exactly is this saying?
