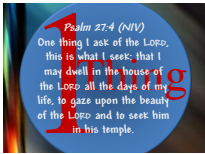
One thing

God was his shelter and shield.

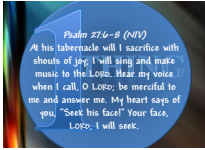
God was his shepherd and keeper.

Do you have an inner longing or hunger?

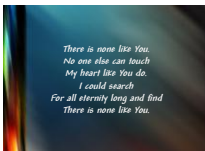
Are you consumed with a desire for more of God?

David said: “My heart says, “Seek God’s face!”

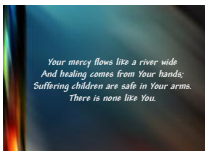
David said: “Your face, Lord, I will seek.”

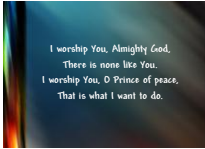
Are you a One Thing person?

There are many things that will take you away.***

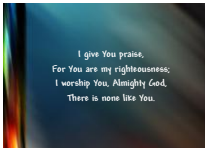
I want to know you Lord.
